### Note 1

A person who wilfully and corruptly makes a false statement in a statutory declaration is liable to the penalties of perjury (s.141 of the Act). Penalty of Imprisonment for not more than 5 years. (s.143 of the Act)

### Note 2 - Qualifications

A statutory declaration under the Evidence Act 1958 (as amended) ("the Act") may be made only (s.107A of the Act ) before a person who is in the following list;
